Sustainability Statement

	Carbon Reduction
CO ₂	 We will work with our clients and suppliers to reduce our greenhouse gas emissions to be carbon neutral by 2025. We are committed to becoming net zero by 2035, in line with the Science-Based Target Initiative's 1.5°C trajectory. We will develop and deliver technical expertise and innovative solutions that contribute to our clients' ambitions to mitigate and adapt to climate change through greater energy efficiency and lower carbon emissions.
	We will sustainably source materials and respect natural resources, prioritising our risks and following the principles within the ISO 20400 Guidance Standard for Sustainable Procurement. We will procure the right volume and type of material and source from known responsible locations. We will work actively with our clients and supply chain, demonstrating a proactive approach to modern slavery, due diligence, labour and human rights.
	We will adopt a circular economy approach and achieve zero avoidable waste by 2028, by embedding the waste hierarchy across all stages and sites, encouraging our clients to do the same. We will promote the efficiency of resources by encouraging refurbishment over demolition and the use of materials that can be readily recoverable.
	We will work with our clients and suppliers to maximise, measure and report on positive social value outcomes for the communities in our area of operational delivery. We will use our technical expertise in stonework, restoration and construction to deliver engagement activities with educational institutions
	We will ensure that all members of our workforce complete ongoing learning on relevant sustainability topics appropriate to their position, supporting them with additional requested training. We have signed up to the GLAA Construction Protocol and People Matter Charter. We will engage with our supply chain to develop their sustainability capabilities, especially across; carbon; resource efficiency; responsible sourcing; community; and people. We will make year-on-year improvements in: fairness, inclusion and respect; equality, diversity and inclusion; skills and training; and workforce culture.
